A Few Things to note:

In order to have the best experience this weekend, please adhere to this packing list and refer questions to your chain of command. *Please watch the weather and plan appropriately. This is a suggested list. You may bring additional items if you so choose.*

1 full set of BDUs/ABUs

- BDU/ABU Blouse (x1) Rolled Sleeves
- BDU/ABU Pants (x1)
- 2 black or desert tan round neck t-shirts
respective to the uniform
- Belt
- BDU/ABU Cover (NO SQUADRON
CAPS)
- Rank insignia (If you aren't a first Sgt at
ENC no Diamonds)
- Boots
- 3 pairs of boot socks and optional liners
- Blousing bands

Weather Gear

- Weather gear (coat) - non-regulation gear
is acceptable

2 sets of PT clothes

- 2 Shorts - black or navy
- 2 T-Shirts - gray
- Running Shoes
- White Athletic Socks

Other Items

- 2 sets of Underwear
- CAPM 39-1 approved sunglasses
- Night/sleep clothes
- Notepad
- Clipboard/Binder
- 2 Pens/Pencils
- 1 Sharpie

- Prepackaged snacks
- Backpack (preferably black)
- Flashlight
- Water bottle/Camelbak
- Sleeping Bag and Pillow (bare cots are
the only bedding provided). There is a mattress
so sheets and a blanket will work.**
- Empty plastic grocery bags
- Towel/hand towel/washcloth
- Foot powder (optional - but you will be
doing everyone a favor if you bring and use it)
- Travel size soap and shampoo
- Toiletries
- Flip-flops as shower shoes
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Shaving cream and razor
- Hairbrush/comb
- Deodorant (no cologne (axe), body spray
or perfume)
- Feminine Hygiene items as appropriate
- Any additional items as appropriate
- Electronics are allowed, only to be used
during personal time

Contraband

- Any illegal substances
